APRN FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM



ADULT GERONTOLOGY ACUTE CARE NURSE PRACTITIONER (AGACNP) FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The AGACNP Fellowship opportunity is a 12-month experience focused on acute care including both direct patient care and didactic lectures. The fellowship program is designed for new-to-practice APRNs (new graduate up to 24 months of experience).

Eligibility:

- Degree from an accredited program
- Certification from a nationally recognized credentialing body (ANCC) with a AGACNP
- Unencumbered license by the Hawaii Board of Nursing

LOCATION:

The Queen's Medical Center's Punchbowl and West O'ahu campuses

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applications open in early fall and close at the end of October. 2-step process of emailed application and an online application with HR if advised by the APRN Fellowship leadership.

Competitive 12-month salary, health and dental insurance, vacation/holiday/sick pay.
