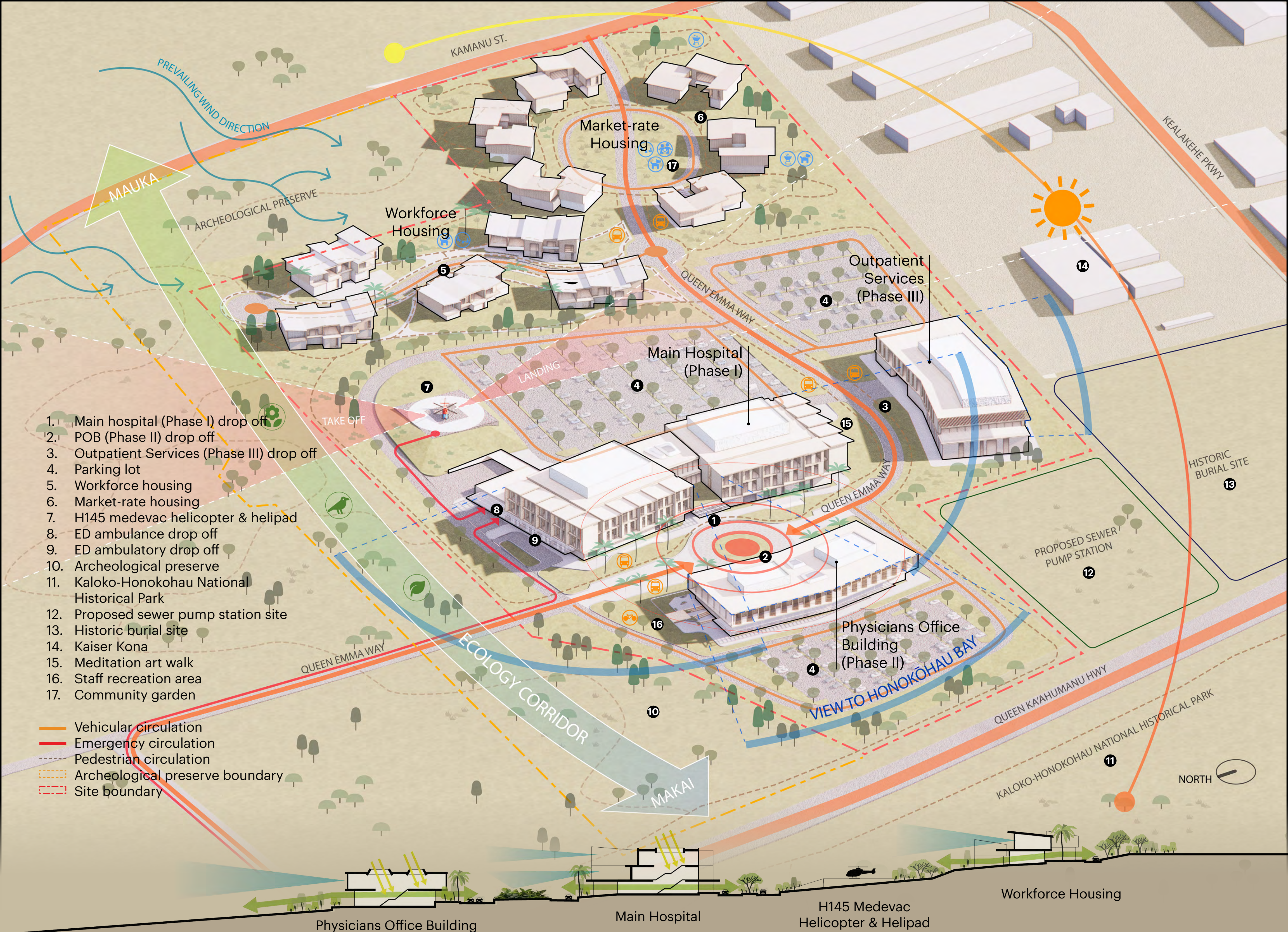
Diverse Housing Opportunities
