

Hawaii Homeless Healthcare Hui (H4) Punawai Medical Respite Program

Hawaii Homeless Healthcare Hui (H4) Punawai Medical Respite Program was opened in February of 2021 by H4 to support homeless individuals who have been hospitalized for acute needs and no longer require hospital care but do require subacute services. Respite Care provides this interim phase of care for individuals who do not have housing. Punawai Medical Respite focuses on providing care and seeking housing for this homeless population. In FY 2022, 71% of the Respite patients received housing placement at discharge.

Total operating expenses for FY 2022 was \$2,224,692 with Queen's Health contributing \$230,902.
